

Access and Support to Education and Training Survey 2008

The 2008 Access and Support to Education and Training Survey (ASETS) is now available for use by researchers working at the Atlantic Research Data Centre. ASETS addresses issues relating to access to post-secondary education, including the role of student financing and participation in adult education and training.

ASETS replaces the Survey of Approaches to Educational Planning (SAEP), the Post-secondary Education Participation Survey (PEPS) and the Adult Education and Training Survey (AETS). ASETS expands the analytical potential of the three separate surveys, in terms of the content that can be addressed, the sample sizes that can be afforded and by allowing the study of correlates across all three themes within the context of lifelong learning. The data collected by ASETS will help to monitor preparedness and access to education, evaluate the effectiveness of government education-related programs and develop policies to deal with the training needs of Canadians.
