

Joint Anomalies Committee Report: 2022-2023

The Joint Anomalies Committee (JAC) meets each year to consider applications received by the deadline date for submissions from faculty members or their respective academic administrators. This year we met on 14 November 2023. Each applicant was informed of the JAC's decision in their particular case via E-mail on 22 November 2023.

A total of 77 eligible applications were received from individual faculty members. As per the collective agreement (Article 31A), an amount of \$ 148,697 was allocated to the Anomalies Fund for 2022-2023, plus a carry-forward of \$71,264, leaving a total of \$ 219,961 available for distribution.

Of the 77 applications, 31 were granted awards from the Anomalies Fund. The total awarded from the Anomalies Fund for 2022-2023 was \$219,961.
