- (3) No fees payable when courses are selected during summer term.
- (4) No fees payable during the Summer, but registration is required. Please note Dalplex membership is included from Sept 1st to Apr 30th; see Dalplex for summer rates.
- (5) Students with health and/or dental insurance may apply for reimbursement until **Opt out date**. www.dalonline.dal.ca. Proof of coverage is required each academic year.
- (6) Student Service Fee includes membership to Dalplex for full-time students from Sept 1st to Apr 30th.
- (7) Students paying programme fee will be required to pay fees three times per academic year.
- (8) Student Upass fee is an 8 month pass assessed to full-time students in the fall term each year, valid until April 30th. Full-time Summer students and those starting in winter term will be charged half rate.
- (9) Facilities Renewal -Recreation Fee is to support athletic and recreation facilities, maximum \$180 per academic year.
- (10) DMCRT means Dalhousie Medical Campus Response Team

International Students:

Registered students who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents are required to pay an additional fee referred to as a "Additional International Tuition". There is a proportional charge for part-time students. Graduate students should refer to the Graduate Studies Calendar to determine the number of years a student is required to pay Additional International Tuition.

*Students enrolled in a Thesis Based Program are charged a reduced fee. Please refer to the Graduate Studies website for a complete list of these programs, www.dalgrad.dal.ca

***International Students-** Students who are not Canadian citizens (or permanent residents) are also required to pay an Additional International Tuition Fee.

There is a proportional charge for part-time international students.

International Student Society Fee - All International Students are assessed a per term International Society Fee of \$ 5.00

Per Class Differential Fee - The amount of differential fee is based on the number of registered billing hours in each term.

Per Course International Tuition – The amount of International Tuition Fee is based on the number of billing hours taken during a term.

Distance Fees -

In addition to tuition and auxiliary fees, students studying off campus may have additional distance fees related to off-campus instruction.

NS Student Bursary -

Nova Scotian students may be eligible for the Nova Scotia Student Bursary up to \$1283 per year.

All Full-Time Students

Students with sufficient, comparable coverage may apply to opt-out of either policy. Proof of coverage is required each academic year

You may apply to opt-out of the health and/or dental policies at www.dalonline.dal.ca no later than Opt out date.

Note: Students are responsible to ensure Tuition and Fees are paid by payment due date to avoid late fees and interest irrespective of the opt-out date.

International Students

International Students are also provided with basic health insurance plan each year. Students charged with the International Health Plan are able to opt-out from the plan if they can provide proof of enrollment in a comparable health plan.

For those who start in other terms, a proportional rate is charged for the remainder of the policy year.
