Detail: The Frederick Tom Parker Award was established in honor of Mr. Parker who was a school principal for 19 years, the President of the Nova Scotia Teachers Union and for 18 years the union executive secretary. In 1969, he came to Dalhousie University and was instrumental in promoting part-time studies. Having spent a lifetime promoting access to education and improving its quality.
