## Notes:

\* 6-credit-hour courses in a single term are the equivalent of two courses in the same term; these cover both Writing Requirement boxes, meaning you will swap another box from the same term and take that course in the other term instead.

Select SUST 1000.06 if you are interested in the **BMgmt Major in Environment, Sustainability & Society (ESS)**. **6-cr-hr single-term writing courses in fall:** If you choose ENGL/CRWR 1030 or SUST 1000, you will take one of ECON 1101, or MGMT 1601 in the winter term instead; swapping places with the Winter Writing Requirement.

Students wishing to declare a **Minor** (in another subject area outside of the Faculty of Management) should consult the appropriate department/Faculty. Minor requirements are typically considered non-commerce electives.
