To apply, you must meet both the Faculty of Graduate Studies' **minimum eligibility** requirements and any additional criteria specific to your program of interest.

Program options & deadlines:

Program options for professional graduate programs vary depending on the degree. Most programs have September and January start dates and are course-based—with many having in-person and online options available.


